Late entries: Open classes only, £3 extra per class if space allows – please call or email.

Rules

- Entries for the Area 18 Qualifiers must be made on the official Riding Club entry form (available for download from <http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-downloads>
Please ensure horses flu vacs are up to date and on the Area 18 Flu vac database
- All entries for open classes must be made using entry form below.
- BACS payments accepted - CDRC account - No 81386220 Sort Code 40-17-10 and give reference DRESS19/3. Notify secretary when payment made.
- Declarations for qualifiers to be made minimum of 30 minutes before the start of the competition.
- Substitutions: Late simple substitutions may be made at the time teams are declared. Complex substitutions must be made by 6pm Wednesday 15th January. A complex substitution is one where teams are re-arranged or horse and rider combinations are moved from one team to another. Simple substitutions are ones where a horse and/or rider replaces the withdrawn one in the same team and position. For complex substitutions email noel.ennett@me.com
- The competition will be run according to current BRC rules.
- Any protest against a decision of the judges should be made in accordance with riding club rule G14 of 2016 rule book.
- **Protective headwear for all classes must comply with BRC rules 2017.** All competitors in the qualifying classes must ensure their hat is tagged by the Official Steward. Accepted hat standards:

British	PAS 015: 1998 or 2011 provided they are BSI Kitemarked VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked
European	VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked
American	ASTM F1163; 2004a or 04a onwards provided they are SEI marked SNELL E2001
Australian & NZ	AS/NZS 3838: 2006 onwards provided they are SAI global marked

- In accordance with BRC rules, jewellery or face/body piercings are not permitted and long hair must be secured so that it does not hang below shoulder height.
- An HSE First Aid At Work-trained volunteer will be on site throughout the competition. Beyond that, cover will be limited to NHS Emergency call out.
- **Dogs are NOT permitted at the venue**

Classes

BRC Intermediate Dressage Qualifying Classes

Class 1 Prelim 7 (2002) – team and individual

Horses not to have any BD points, except prelim points.

Class 2 Novice 30 (2006) – team and individual

Horses up to 124 points

Class 3 Novice 34 (2009) – team and individual

Horses up to 124 points

Class 4 Elementary 49 (2009) – team and individual

Horses up to 199 points

Class 5 Pick A Test Medium 71 (2002) / Advanced Medium 90 (2012) – individual

Horses up to 299 points (med) or 425 points (adv med)

N.B. For the Intermediate TEAM competition, each member of the team of 4 rides a different dressage test from classes 1-4. Teams must be made of all seniors or all juniors. Individuals for all classes may be seniors or juniors.

Open Classes (entries may be restricted or classes cancelled dependent upon the number or Area Qualifier entries and time available)

Class 6 Intro A (2008)

Split into restricted and open sections – please state on entry form. Restricted entries never to have come 1st or 2nd in an Intro test. In the event of low entries R and O will be merged into a single class

Class 7 Prelim 12 (2005)

Split into restricted and open sections – please state on entry form. Restricted entries never to have come 1st or 2nd in a Prelim test. In the event of low entries R and O will be merged into a single class

Class 8 Novice 24 (2010)

Class 9 Elementary 44 (2002)

The organisers cannot guarantee that these classes will be suitable as warm up for the qualifying classes as times will be totally dependent on entries.
