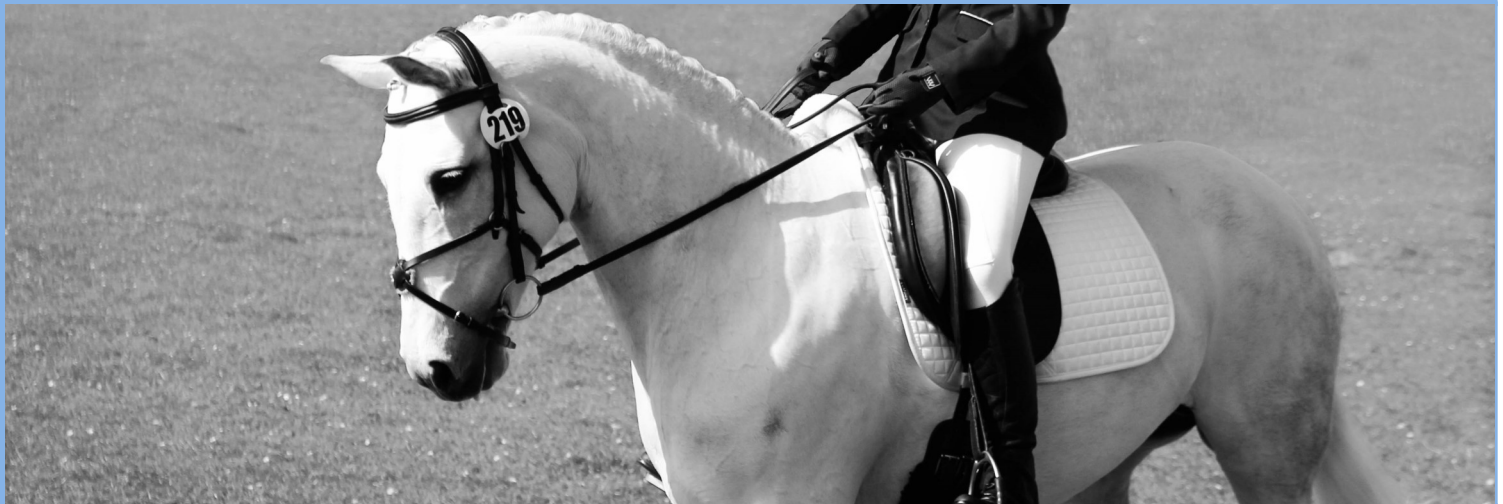

### Rules for the SSRC Dressage Championships 2017

1. Qualifying Competitions include all SSRC and Kyre dressage competitions from October 2017 to September 2018. Additional qualifying competitions may also be added during the season and will be notified on the individual schedule or on our website.
2. Every SSRC member who scores over 62% in a SSRC dressage class qualifies for the SSRC Dressage Championships, at that level, (EXCLUDING WALK & TROT).
3. The Walk and Trot Championship is open to all SSRC competitors who have entered a WALK & TROT test at Qualifying Dressage Competition between dates on point 1. BUT ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE PRELIMINARY CHAMPIONSHIP.
4. Walk & Trot - if registered with BD the combination is not eligible to take part in this Walk & Trot Championships
5. Prelim - if at BD the Combination has more than 20 points they are not eligible to take part in Prelim
6. Competitors who qualify the same horse at different levels can only enter the Championship **at the highest level** for which they have qualified.
7. Any competitor riding more than one horse will be permitted to qualify each horse up to a maximum of two horses in any Championship class.
8. Horses having more than 124 British Dressage points are ineligible for the Novice Championship.
9. Horses having more than 199 British Dressage points are ineligible for the Elementary Championship.
10. Horses having more than 299 British Dressage points are ineligible for the Medium Championship.
11. Tests may be commanded and whips may be carried.
12. Please respect the competition venue, keep all dogs on short leads, pick up any droppings your horse may leave and take note of any parking/one way etc...systems in place.
