ALL Classes – Dressage, followed by arena jumping (SJ and simulated XC)

The cross country part of the jumping phase will be timed

Dressage times will be available on www.bromsgroveridingclub.co.uk from 9pm Friday 19th August

Jumping rounds must be undertaken within 30 minutes of the dressage test

The course will be available to walk from 4pm on Saturday 20th August

For Mercian Teams there will be a break before classes 2B and 3A to allow team competitors to walk the course

In classes 2B and 3A Mercian rules apply

Only one team per Riding Club in each Mercian class

HEALTH AND SAFETY

This event has been organised in accordance with health and safety legislation. Everything reasonably practical has been done to ensure the health, safety and welfare of those attending the event.

For these measures to be effective, everyone attending must conduct themselves in a manner, which does not put themselves or anyone else at risk.

Emergency vehicles must have access to the sites at all times and members of the public must not park so as to obstruct access.

RULES

- The event will be run under British Riding Club (BRC) rules.
- The judges' decision is final.
- Classes will be split for juniors and seniors (juniors under 18 on 1st January 2016), where entries per class exceed 6.
- Competitors may not walk the course when a class is underway.
- Tack and dress will be checked by the jumping steward.
- **IMPORTANT - The BRC hat standards have been changed for 2016.** All riders and competitors **MUST** wear a hard hat whilst mounted that meets one of the following criteria: PAS015 (1998 or 2011) & BSI kite mark, ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) & SEI mark, VGI 01.040 (2014-12) & BSI kite mark, SNELL E2001 & official SNELL label and number or AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) & SAI global mark. Hats only to standard EN1384 or BSEN1384, not bearing any of the above, are not permitted.
- Body protectors and medical armbands are compulsory for the jumping phase (recommended standard BETA 3). Medical armbands can be purchased from the BHS bookshop 08701 201918, Pony Club HQ or British Eventing. Anyone wearing a body cage must report to the secretary before competing.
- Dressage phase - jacket with shirt and tie/stock.
- Jumping phase - jacket or cross country colours.
- Stop watches are not permitted.
- All entries must be accompanied by the correct remittance.
- The show organisers do not accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury, etc which may be sustained by persons, horses or ponies, vehicles or property, servants in connection with, or arising out of the event. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each competitor shall agree to indemnify the organisers against any such accident.
- The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event, or amend any of the conditions as they think fit.
- No horse or pony under the age of four may compete.
- Excessive use of whips and spurs will result in disqualification.
- The BDRC Committee strongly recommend that the Paramedic present assesses a rider after a fall before they continue with the competition.
- Everyone must follow the instructions of the stewards and committee.
- Objections must be handed to the secretary in writing with a £20.00 deposit within half an hour of any incident. No refunds will be given for withdrawals. In the case of bad weather a 50% refund will be given on receipt of an SAE, to be received within 7 days of the cancellation.

SCORING

Refusals, run-outs, circling and falls are only penalised if, in the opinion of the judge concerned, they are connected with the negotiation or attempted negotiation of one of the numbered obstacles.
